SUBJECT: Impending Release of Additional Information in Response to FOIA Request

Mr. Cuneo:

This letter is to inform you, pursuant to 32 C.F.R. § 286.10(i), of the current position of the Department of Defense (“DoD”) regarding the Freedom of Information Act (“FOIA”) request from your client the American Small Business League (“ASBL”) for the Sikorsky comprehensive Small Business Subcontracting Plan for Fiscal Year 2013.

DoD has recently determined that certain previously withheld information does not warrant protection from disclosure under the FOIA. The DoD has determined that none of the remaining information should be withheld under 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(4).

Pursuant to 32 CFR 286.10(i), this letter serves as notice to ASBL that the DoD has notified Sikorsky, via a letter dated March 8, 2018, that the DoD intends to disclose the requested information, over Sikorsky’s objections, on March 15, 2018.
